

## Call for applications for a 24-month postdoctoral fellowship in Open Science, Research Data and AI at Lyon 1 Claude Bernard University

**Position definition:** Postdoctoral Fellowship

**Contract duration:** 24 months

**The successful candidate is expected:**

- To conduct their research project as submitted in relation with the research groups indicated above
- To contribute to develop methodologies addressing the analysis of Research Data sharing practices
- To contribute to the analysis of the role of AI in shaping Open Science practices
- To participate to the organization of scientific events (seminars, research meeting, conferences...)
- To be part of the seminars held at Wrocław or London
- To contribute to working papers, research reports, etc.
- To contribute to peer-reviewed publications (which may come during and at the end of the contract)

- To contribute to the visibility to the project and its outcomes (Website, X, RG, ...)
- Teaching activities are also possible for candidates who are interested in.

### **Employment conditions**

- Selected candidates will be recruited on a two-year contract from March, or April 2024, according their availability
- The remuneration is 2600 € gross (*salaire brut*) per month. Employment in France guarantees full access to healthcare, other social security benefits and social acquis (such contribution to transport costs).
- The successful candidate will benefit from Lyon 1 Claude Bernard University working environment.
- Working languages are English and French. Mastering French is helpful, but not required for the position. Publications expected to derive from the projects will be in English.

- Two reference letters
- Recruitment interviews will be scheduled by mid-March 2024.
